

What is EQUIP all about?

EQUIP is a course for anyone at either church who would like to be better equipped to serve God in Church life.

What will the course cover?

EQUIP will start in January 2023 and will involve 17 sessions over the year. The sessions will include:

- An outline of core evangelical doctrine
- An introduction to the principles of Christian ministry
- Training on how to read the bible with other people
- An introduction to biblical counselling
- Training on small group and personal evangelism
- A session on how best to use our gifts to serve God

Who is EQUIP for?

We hope that this course will be both useful and practical for anyone who would like to serve God better in church life.

Our prayer is that by the end of the course everyone will feel better equipped to use their gifts and talents to serve God. This may involve helping with the leadership of our midweek small groups, supporting our pastoral care teams or supporting our outreach ministries to the local community.
